We got to see 'how the sausage was made' at the giant corporations - in the cellars, in the streets, and in the boardrooms. Our goal has been to make honest wines that offer great value without the industrial trickery needed to make millions of cases. Wine crafted from grape to glass, true to varietal character and expressive of California's bold style. A cure for industrial wines...and just in case the corporate powers came after us we took on an ALIAS.

TASTING NOTES

When I drink this wine, it transports me to a perfect sunny day.

Honeydew melons, grapefruit, hibiscus, papaya, key lime and a hint of coconut water. If it had an SPF rating, I'd rub it all over me and layout by the pool...which I neither confirm nor deny trying.

The wine has bright acidity of lime citrus and green apples, but a long finish of tropical notes and summer melons.

I love this wine chilled cold, poured heavy, paired with grilled peaches, shellfish, and a fresh salad. If you are the type of person that likes jumping naked into cool water and hammocks bring you joy, we captured that feeling in a bottle. Enjoy.
