This combines the best management practices from other farming systems, like organic and biodynamic, to positively impact the bottom line, environment, and society.

## 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon

Our quest for world-class Cabernet Sauvignon led us south along the Santa Lucia range to Paso Robles, where hot days are cooled by fog and wind coming in from the mountain gap. It is here that legendary winemaker, Don Brady, and industry veteran Randy Johnston, farm the Royal Estrella Vineyard, the main source for this wine. Located at the center of the region, the vines benefit from an extreme diurnal range, where days can reach over 100°F and drop to 50°F in the night. The result is big, ripe fruit and tannins with refreshing acidity and aroma. Led by Brady's experience and expertise, this Cabernet Sauvignon is an exciting new chapter in the story of Le Mistral.
