The White Witch is our name for the westerly wind that blows each afternoon through our vines in the Arroyo Seco AVA of Monterey County. This is nature using its magic for good, allowing temperatures to climb during the day, the wind cools the vines in afternoon, while river rocks strewn throughout the vineyard release back the warmth they collected in the heat. This gradual change in temperature produce the beautiful layers and rich textures of this blend of white Rhône varieties. The nose pulls you in with exciting aromas of floral, citrus, and wet river rocks. On the palate, lively citrus notes are rounded by flavors of melon, pear, and stone fruits. The complex flavors meld together with bright, balanced acidity to create a blend that will delight a wide range of tastes and food pairings.
